English

The children will be learning how to write a set of instructions and setting descriptions using expanded noun phrases.

Pupils will also be writing their very own Fairy Tale with a twist.

Maths

The children will be learning how to identify and represent numbers using objects. They will use the language of equal to, more than, less than, most and least. They will also learn how to count up in 10s from any number. They will be exploring addition and subtraction by number bonds to ten to support adding larger numbers. They will be using number lines to support when adding and subtracting as well as using partitioning.

Science

This term the children will use a variety of materials, learning why each material has been chosen to make that product. They will also learn about what a human needs to survive, focusing on exercise, a balanced diet and hygiene.

PSHE

This term the children will explore 'Safer Relationships'. They will learn about making decisions to keep them safe and what to do if they feel unsafe in different situations.

Autumn Term



Design Technology

This term in DT, pupils will be developing their understanding of the design, make and evaluate process while making a healthy smoothie.

RE

This term the children will be learning about Who made the World, focusing on the Creation story. We will also be learning about Why Christmas matters to Christians.

Art

This term we will explore the colour wheel and create abstract portraits in the style of Picasso.

Computing

Using Purple Mash, they will learn how to create algorithms to make a computer programme operate. They will also complete an e-safety assessment which will inform their personalised e-safety learning.

History

During History this term we will explore the changes that have taken place in toys and technology over time.

Geography

After half term, in Geography we will be learning about what makes each continent different from the others.

PE

The children will take part in gymnastics this term. They will learn how to balance, travel and put their own routine together. Outdoors, they will build on their football skills by applying them to game situations beginning to use tactics.
