Dear Parents

It is proposed to arrange a visit to Ash End House Farm on Tuesday 8th March 2022. This will support the children's learning about animals.

The children will leave school at approximately 9am and return to school at 3.00pm. Please be aware that the children may be a little later than this depending on traffic.

Please login to Parent Pay to pay and give consent for your child to attend by 18th February to enable the visit arrangements to be completed and confirmed. The children will travel by coach.

As this visit takes place mainly in school time it is necessary to ask for a voluntary contribution of £18.80 per pupil, of which PTFA are paying £5.00 per pupil, therefore a contribution of £13.80 per pupil will be required. There is no obligation to contribute and no pupil will be omitted from the visit because they do not pay or do not pay in full. However, the visit cannot go ahead if the school does not receive sufficient contributions by 18th February 2022. This contribution will go towards the cost of the entrance fee, tour, transport and insurance.

Your child will be expected to be responsible enough to wear a seatbelt provided until informed it may be released.

The children will need to be dressed in uniform on the top but can wear non-uniform trousers suitable for a farm visit and comfortable footwear. Please ensure they also have a warm waterproof coat and wellies. A packed lunch will be required with a drink in a non-breakable container. If you would like our kitchen to make your child a packed lunch, please make your order before 18th February by either phoning or emailing the office. The children do not need to bring any money.

All bona fide educational visits by Staffordshire schools are covered by the County Council's public liability insurance, as are all in-school activities. This visit is considered to have only normal everyday risks and no further insurance has been provided.
