# Weekly round up - Nursery

This week in Nursery we have been learning all about the season of Autumn and the signs and changes we see that tell us Autumn is here. We listened to the story 'After the Storm' and talked about the characters, where the story took place and what happened in the story.

In topic we looked at different Autumn photographs and talked about the differences in the leaves on the trees and the weather. We went on an Autumn walk around school and collected natural objects to put in our investigation tray, we used the magnifying glasses to look closely at the objects and described what we saw.

We listened to a story about an acom which told us all about its life cycle. The children made their own books showing the different stages of how an acom grows into an oak tree and then how the cycle starts all over again.

The children learnt what the word hibernation means, they looked at animals who hibernate and found out what they do before hibernation and their habitats.
