Behaviour Policy

Last week we launched our new behaviour policy with pupils. The policy introduces a number of new rewards including our very exciting house token collection box. We have also provided all pupils from reception to year 4 with a 'Value Card' which means that they can collect stickers relating specifically to each of our core Christian values. These replace the old merit system and at the end of each half term, children will have the opportunity to trade in their stickers for a prize!

The school sanction system also looks quite different as a new light model has been introduced. Teaching staff will be talking through the new policy during the 'meet the teacher' session this evening the full version of which is available on our school website.
